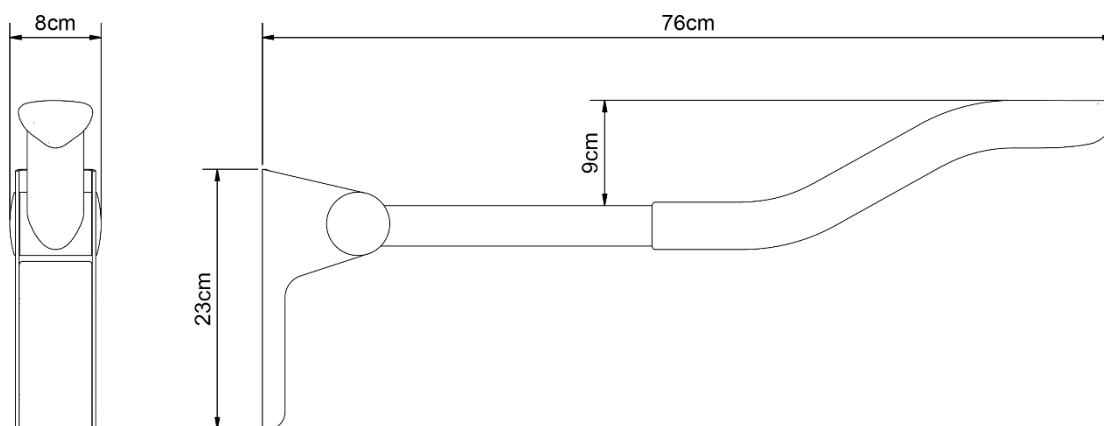

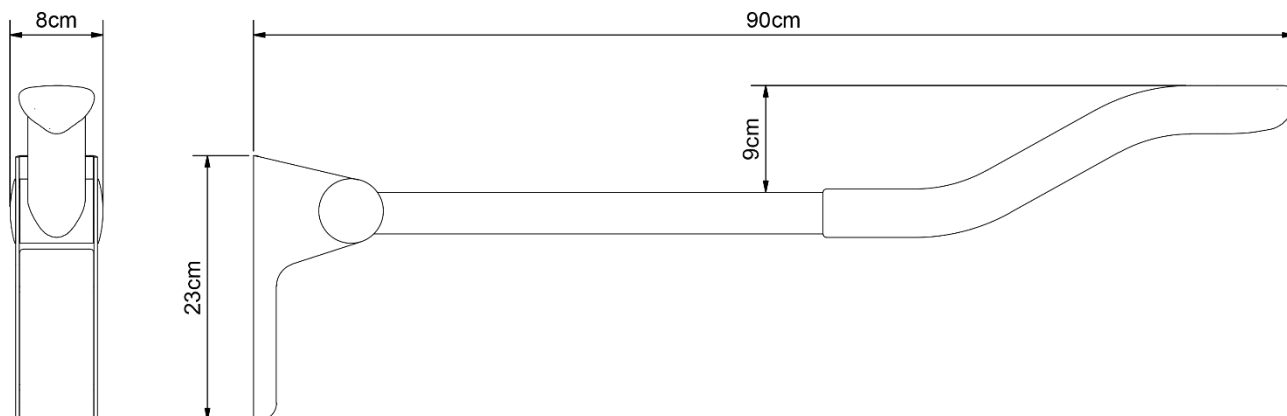

4. Instructions for use

4.1 Mounting interfaces

All models of Straight and Wave

Construction

The wall must be made of screw-retaining material approved for wet rooms.

The shaded area indicates the minimum area for wall reinforcement.

Reinforcement is best installed from floor to ceiling.

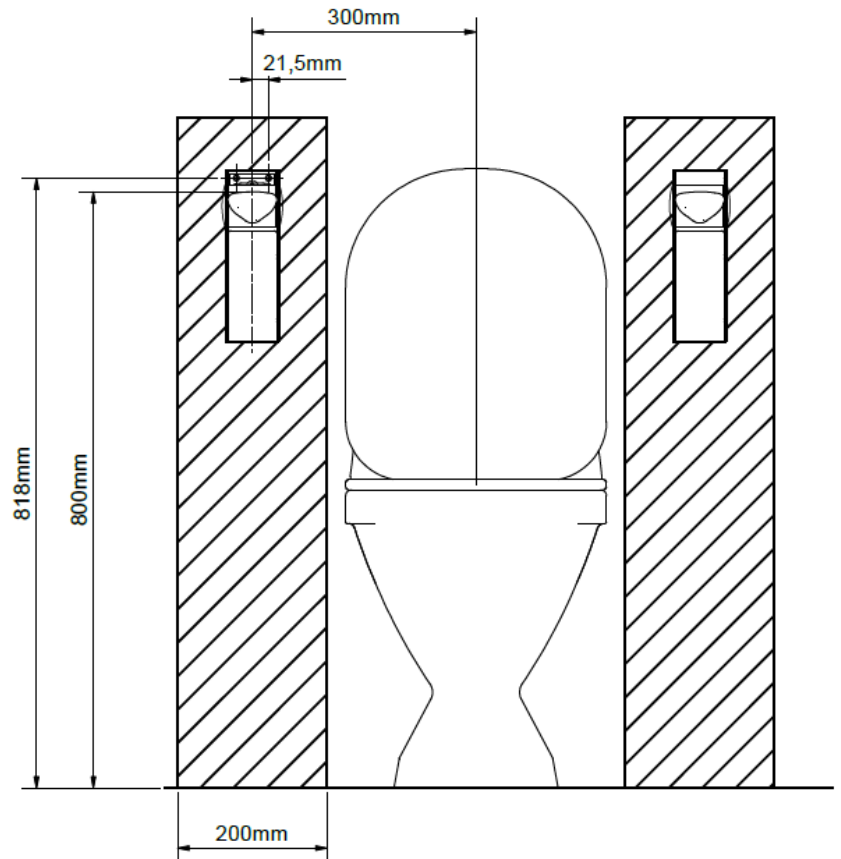

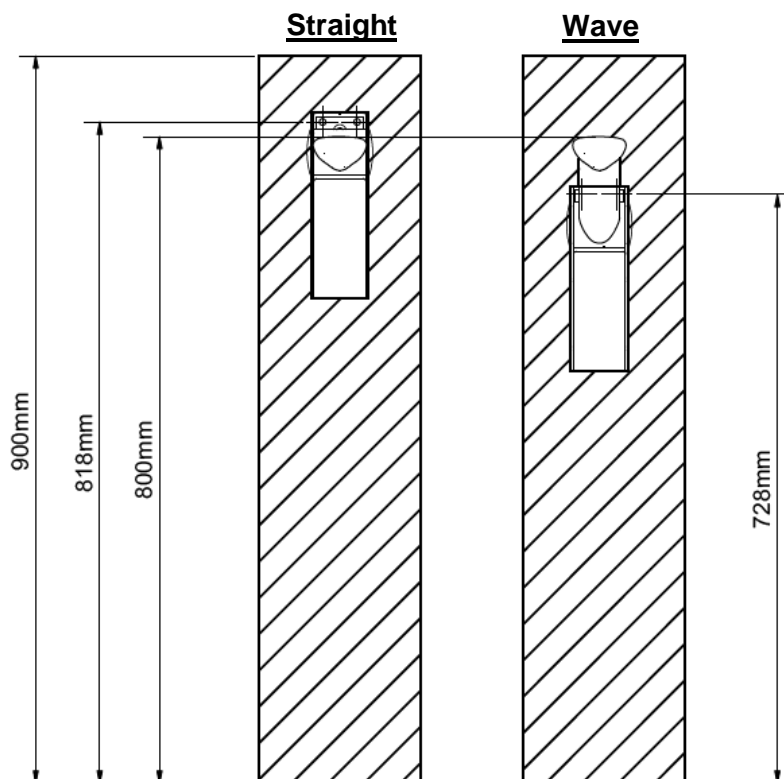
Please note

All measurements are based on a fixed height of the toilet support of 800 mm above floor level. If this measurement is to be changed, the recommended measurements must be changed accordingly.

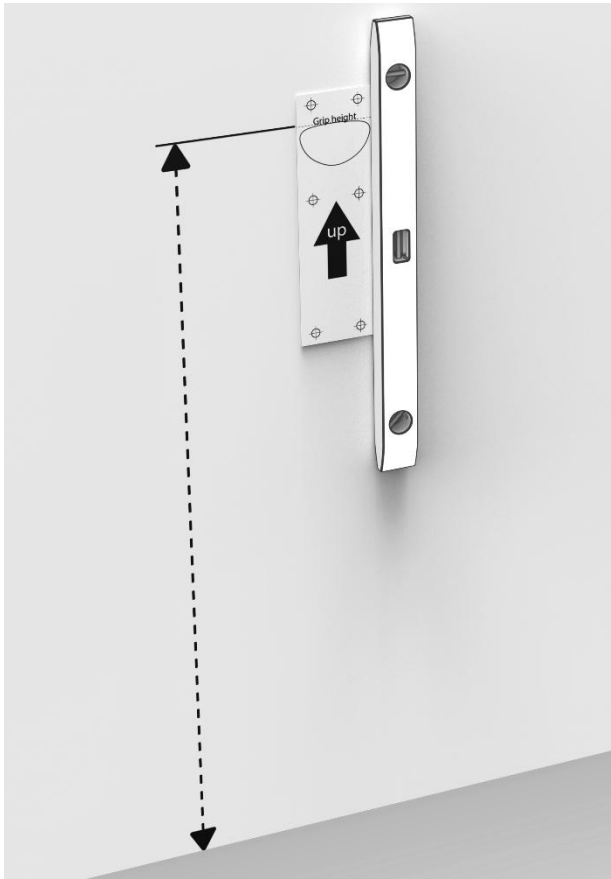
The unit comes with a set (6 pcs) of screws and wall plugs that are intended for mounting on a concrete wall. The installer must always assess the material, nature and strength of the wall and use suitable screws and wall plugs for that particular type of wall.

A mounting template is enclosed for marking out the 6 mounting holes on the bracket.

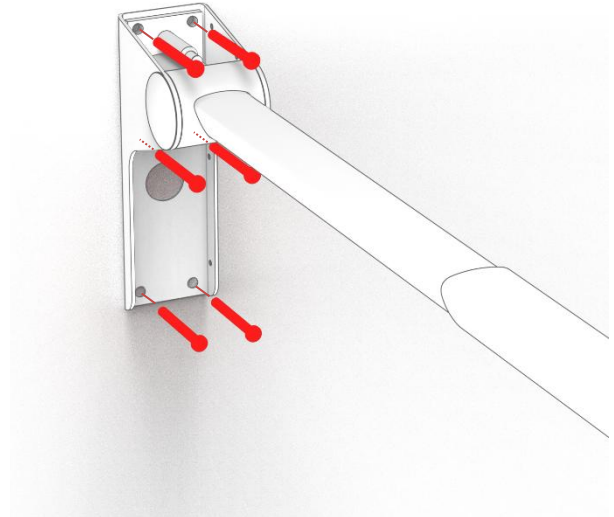
User heights (top edge of toilet support) and installation heights (top holes in template/bracket).



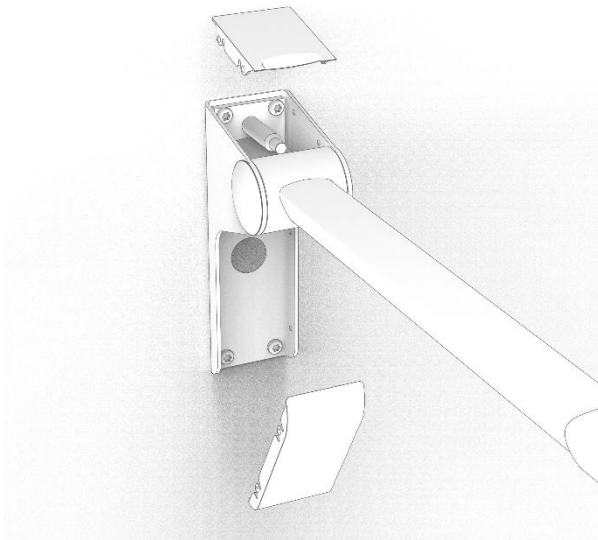
4.2 Installation instructions



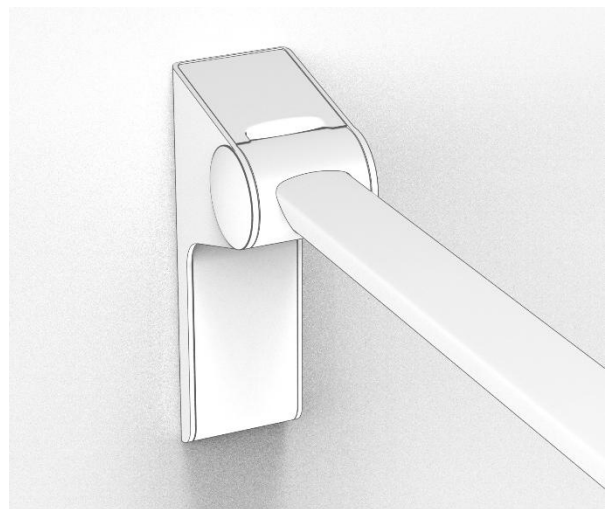
1. Use the included mounting template to mark the holes based on the desired height of the toilet seat. The dotted line on the template marks where the top of the handle will be.
2. Drill the holes and insert suitable wall plugs.



3. Screw the toilet support to the wall. Be careful not to hit the drum with the screwdriver when installing the top screws.



4. Install the upper and lower cover plate.

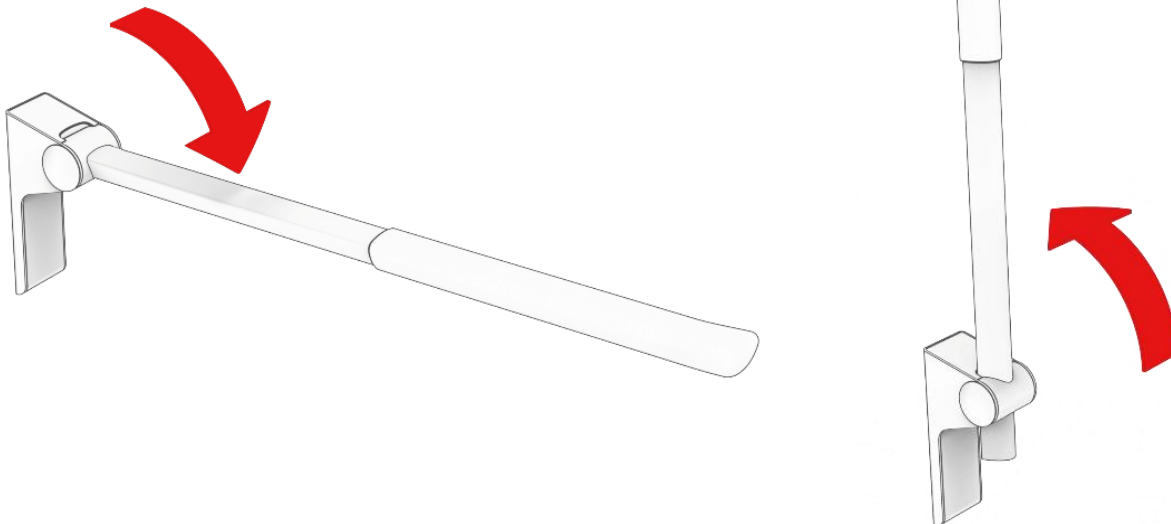


Warning!

Before using the product for the first time, always load test it yourself. This is to ensure that the product is properly attached to the wall. If this is not done, the user risks serious bodily injury from a fall should the toilet support not be properly attached.

4.3 Operating the product

The toilet support can rotate 90° to vertical position.
The support is designed to be left in any position between 0° and 90° angle.



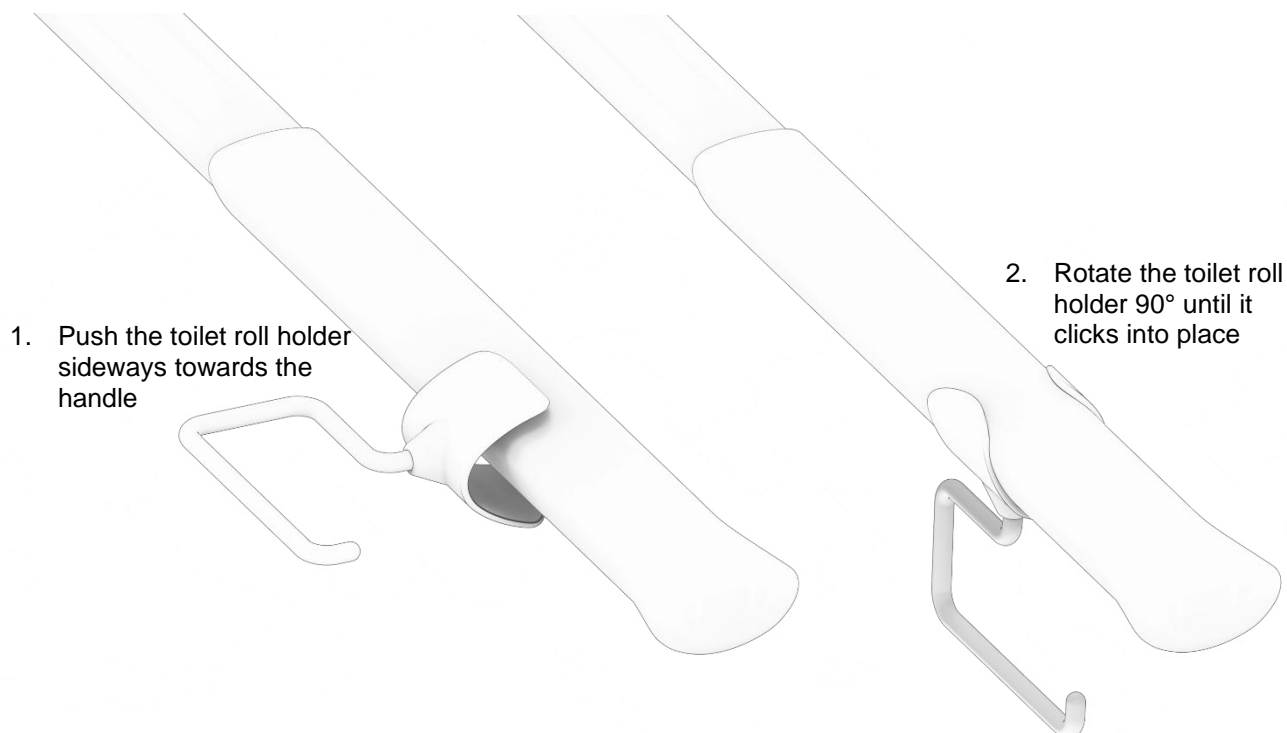
Warning!

Always position the product so that it can move freely through its intended arc without hitting anything. Failure to comply may result in loss of product stability.

4.4 Use of toilet roll holder (optional extra)

Installation of toilet roll holder

The toilet roll holder can be optionally mounted on the rubber handle



Orientation of the toilet roll

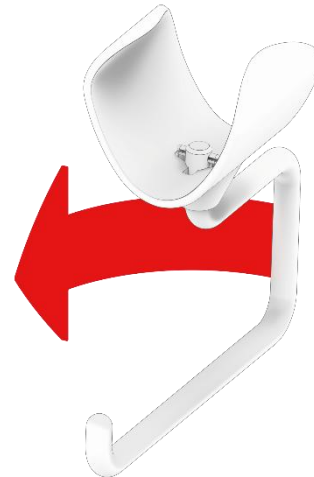
The toilet roll holder can be customised to hold the toilet roll in two different directions as desired

The toilet roll holder must be removed before orientation can be changed

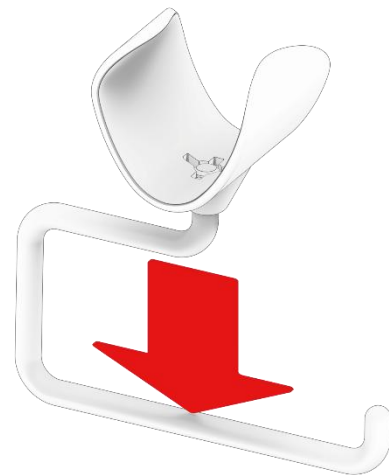
1. Push the holder up through the plastic bracket



2. Once the cross-pin is free of the plastic, the holder can be rotated 90° and pulled back into the plastic bracket



3. The toilet roll holder can now be reinstalled on the toilet seat




4.5 Adjusting friction discs

In some cases, the toilet support can no longer be left in a given position between 0° and 90°, but drops back down to 0°. In such cases, the friction discs need to be readjusted. Follow these 3 steps:

- 1) Remove the round side covers, e.g. with a small flat screwdriver
- 2) Use a Torx 20 screwdriver to tighten one or both screws. Test along the way if the toilet support stays where it is left. Be careful not to overtighten the screws as this can make the support unnecessarily difficult to adjust.
- 3) Click the two side covers back on by pressing the two snap-fit tabs into the corresponding holes.

4.6 Safe use

	Caution! <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toilet support arms can become slippery when wet• Be careful not to pinch your fingers when folding the toilet support arm up/down• Carers or other personnel should avoid putting their feet under the support leg when folding it down
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5. Cleaning

Clean using lukewarm water and a suitable all-purpose cleaner. Use a cloth or soft sponge to wash the product. Wipe the product with a wrung-out cloth.


For surface disinfection, chlorine-based disinfectants can be used as long as product specifications and safety precautions are followed, but the concentration must not exceed 1,000 ppm active chlorine. Ethanol-based disinfectants can also be used as long as product specifications and safety precautions are followed.

The following products have been tested by Ropox and can be used as long as they are diluted according to the product instructions.

5.1 Pre-approved disinfectants

Immediately after cleaning or disinfection, wipe the product with a cloth soaked in water and then a dry towel, otherwise the product may become discoloured or stained and the surface treatment may be damaged. Please note that the product can be expected to lose some shine or colour after prolonged use with normal cleaning intervals. The product can be disinfected independent of cleaning.






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6. Maintenance

The toilet support is maintenance free. For safety reasons, we recommend regular inspection of all bolted connections and moving parts to ensure that no parts are loose and that fastenings to the wall are intact.
