

Use

The unit is designed to quickly height adjust the shower seat and backrest with arms without the use of any tools. The height can be adjusted by pulling the handle towards you and positioning the seat in the preferred height. The handle falls automatically back in its slot. This ensures that the seat is always in a secure position and safe to sit on. The unit is weight balanced, making it easy to adjust with just one hand.

By placing the unit in the recommended position on the wall the seat can adjust from 400-525 mm / 15,7 - 20,6 in above the floor.


Construction

The wall must consist of proper screw material approved for wet rooms.

In accordance with DS/ISO 17966 the max user weight is 150 kg / 330 lb. For the arm support it is 50 kg / 110 lbs per arm.

The hatched areas indicate the minimum area for reinforcements in the wall.

Maximum load on each top screws: 50 kg / 110 lb.



NOTE:

All dimensions are based on a seat without leg with height adjustable between 400 - 525mm (12 3/4" – 20 2/3") above floor level. If a change of these dimensions is required, the recommended dimensions must be changed accordingly.

The unit is supplied with a set of 8 screws and rawlplugs suitable for mounting on a concrete wall. The fitter should always consider the material, condition and strength of the wall and use screws and rawlplugs suitable for the specific wall type.

Cleaning

During use, the product may get dirty. It is very important to clean the product as described in these instructions.

Wipe the unit with a wrung cloth with lukewarm water and a mild detergent. Do not use enchanters, abrasives or grinding cloths, brushes and sponges.

Disinfection may be done with household spirits.

Each unit has a label of its own as illustrated. This label contains important information to be stated in connection with inquiries to the supplier.





Mounting instructions

NOTE:



User information

Safety in use

- The seat and backrest must only be adjusted in height by persons who have read and understood these instructions.
- Always use the unit in a manner excluding the risk of damage to persons or property. The person operating the washbasin is responsible for avoiding damage or injury.
- Modifications, which may influence the performance or design of Ropox Support Washbasin, are not allowed.
- Installation, service and repairs must be carried out by competent personnel.
- During inspection, service or repairs any load must be removed from the unit.

The unit is maintenance-free. Moving parts have been lubricated for life. For reasons of safety and reliability, we recommend inspection of the unit once a year.
